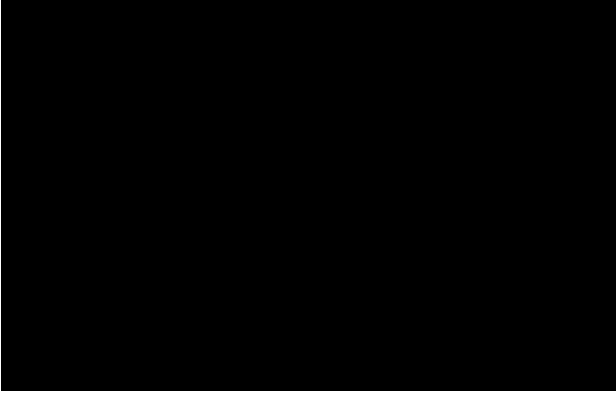


BSN Nursing

12 credits in the major and 9 credits in the minor must be completed at Alvernia University
When pursuing a double major, you must have 12 distinct credits between the two majors.

Students may not withdraw from any single NUR course more than one time and may not withdraw (without receiving a grade) from more than two total NUR courses during the time they are enrolled in the nursing program. 238

Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5. Students whose cumulative GPA falls below 2.5 will be placed on Nursing Department academic probation for one semester and may be academically dismissed from the Nursing Program if the GPA does not meet the minimum standard by the end of the next regular semester.

Successful completion of ATI Computer Assessments as specified in course syllabi.

Students must display professional, ethical behavior in the classroom and clinical setting as outlined in the BSN Student Handbook.

Adhere to policies found in the BSN Student Handbook, the Alvernia University catalog, and the Undergraduate Student Handbook.

Students who fail to meet the BSN Program progression standards will be notified in writing by the Chief Nursing Officer of their dismissal from the program and referred to academic advising for assistance in selecting a new major. Students who do not drop any NUR courses from their class schedules within one month of this notification will be removed from these courses.
